ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

These Articles of Incorporation are signed and acknowledged by the incorporators for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1931, as amended, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

ARTICLE II.

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To provide a formal organization to utilize the interest, time and facilities of the Honorary Commanders duly appointed to that position in the Michigan Naval Militia and the Michigan Military Establishment, constituting the membership of the Commanders Club of Michigan.
2. To promote the best interests of the State of Michigan, particularly in the areas of water safety, water recreational facilities, boating facilities and improve marine recreational development and regulation.
3. To promote and expand the recruiting, training and educational facilities of marine oriented associations such as the Sea Scouts, Naval Reserve, U. S. Power Squadron and similar marine oriented groups.
4. To cooperate with and to promote activities of the United States Navy by full cooperation with the Navy League.
5. To develop and promote an organization available to carry out any civilian functions requested by proper authority.
